## Hate Crime / Hate Incident

*“Any incident, which constitutes a criminal offence, which is perceived by the victim or any other person as being motivated by prejudice or hate.”*

Hatred is the targeting of individuals, groups and communities because of who they are. A hate crime is any criminal offence that is motivated by hostility or prejudice based upon the victim's:

- Disability
- Race
- Religion or belief
- Sexual orientation
- Transgender
- Age
- Gender

All hate crime is important. No hate crime or incident is too minor to report to the police. Anyone can be the victim of a hate crime. We all have a racial identity, all have a sexual orientation, all have some sort of beliefs. Anyone of us could be targeted because of some aspect of our identity. Tackling hate crime supports each and every one of us.

### Reporting incidents to the police

If you or your property is in danger then you **MUST** telephone the police straight away on 999. Tell the call taker that you are reporting a hate crime and that you and/or your property is in danger. Hate crime is a high priority crime and someone will come to you as soon as possible. If you or your property are not in any immediate danger, for example, you have seen some transphobic graffiti then you call GMP on 0161 872 5050.

The police encourage all our communities to report all hate crime.
