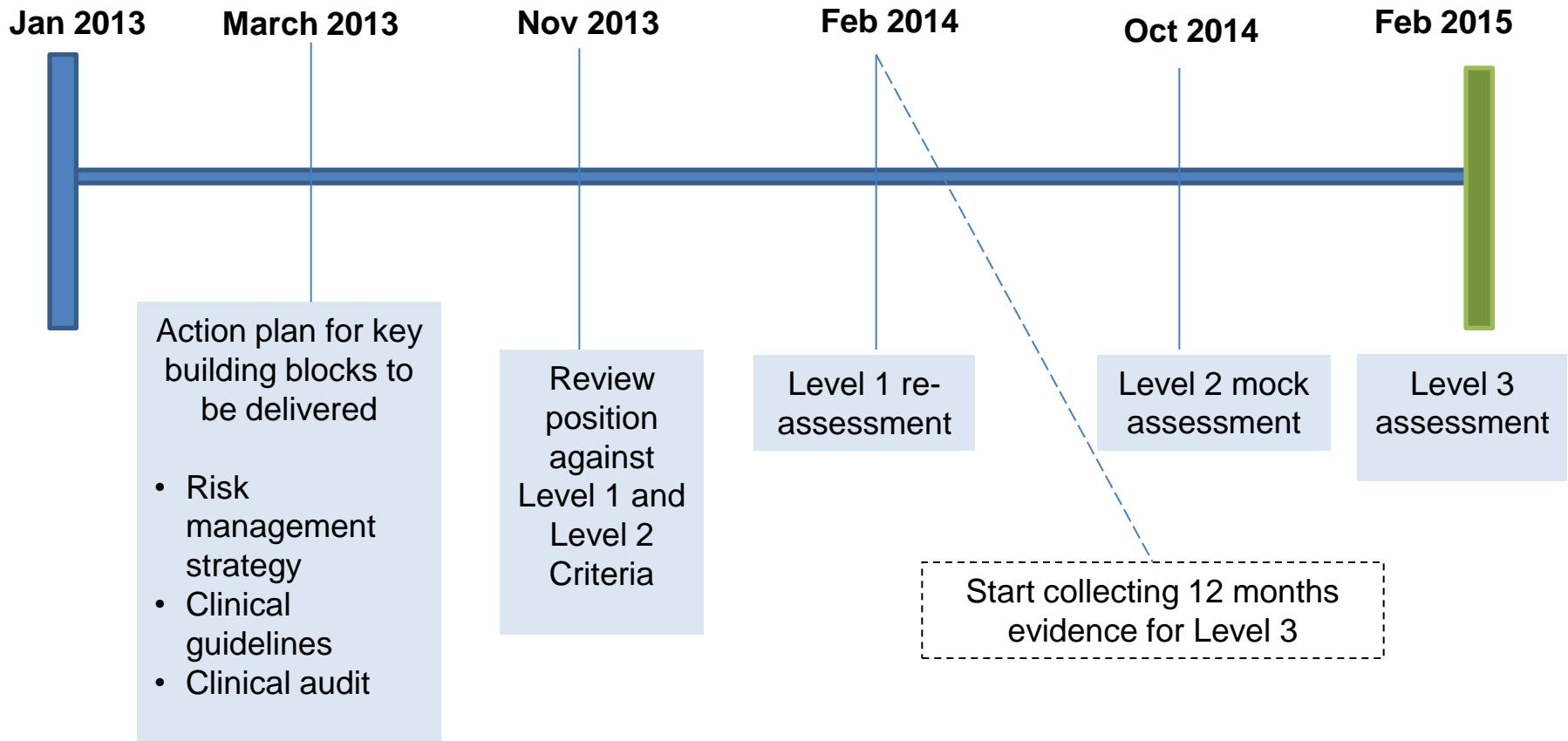

Background

- Five CNST assessments since 2004, which have achieved Level 1
 - **For mothers and babies** - Level 1 means that *‘The process for managing risks has been described and documented’*
- We are presenting to the Board a high level plan to achieve CNST Level 3 by February 2015
 - **For mothers and babies** – Level 3 means that ‘The process for managing risks described at Level 1 is working across the entire maternity service and that where deficiencies have been identified through audit and monitoring, action plans have been put in place to reduce the risks
- **Ultimately this is about delivering the best possible, evidence based care for mothers and babies in North Cumbria**
